Highflyers excursions begin next week. We apologise for the short notice with notes etc but we were trying very hard to source cheaper bus quotes. The cost of hiring buses has risen noticeably this year and we have been concerned about the impact it has on excursion costs. Although the charge for Highflyers is below the amount estimated in the 2014 outline of Charges and Contributions it is much more per session than we had expected. As these sessions are extremely worthwhile we have decided to go ahead with them but will be seeking parent feedback before planning excursions for 2015.
