

With the new fence enclosing the area, our students can independently enjoy exploring the space as well.















# **Key Word Sign**

## **School Bus Service**

It is important that families are aware that Transport Assistance Applications for 2024 need to be submitted via the School Bus Services website <u>www.schoolbuses.wa.gov.au</u> by <u>Friday 24</u> <u>November 2023.</u> Applications received after this date will not be processed in time for the start of term 1 2024.

Families already receiving Transport Assistance either via an orange school bus or a conveyance allowance do not need to reapply if there are no changes to their circumstances for instance the address has not changed, and the student is not changing school. A new application is required if students have changed their address or are changing schools in 2024
