

School Bus Services receives a high number of applications for Transport Assistance prior to the end of the year which results in longer than expected processing times. We ask for your patience and understanding during these busy times.

If your application is submitted after 15th December for the following school year, your application may not be processed until the first few weeks of Term the following year.

Djilba is the season from August to September. It is the time of the second rains.

During this season, the days begin to become warmer and the nights are still cooler, but the rain is slowing. The people collected plant roots and hunted emu, kangaroo, possums and bandicoot. This is the start of the massive flowering explosion that happens in the South West. This starts with the yellow flowering plants such as the Acacias. Also colours that are around at this time of year are creams, combined with some vivid and striking blues.
