Our Key

Word Signs for this fortnight are:

circle

Extend dominant index finger. Draw a circle in front of body. (Natural gesture).

play

Simultaneously move both open hands, palms up, in outward circles.

stop

Move open dominant hand forward, palm away from body, from shoulder height. (Natural gesture).

draw

Form an "O" with index and thumb of dominant hand. Move along above palm of open non-dominant hand as though writing/drawing.

## Supporting Families through Stepping Stones – Triple P Parenting Program

Our School Psychologist, Kristy Mollet, and Chaplain, Skye Johnson, have been facilitating the *Stepping Stones – Triple P* (Positive Parenting Program) sessions with parents every Thursday morning throughout the term.

These sessions are designed to provide practical, evidence-based strategies to support families of children with additional needs.



The program focuses on:

- Learning 25 effective parenting strategies – allowing you to choose what works best for your family and your child's individual needs
- Supporting your child in developing key life skills such as routines, communication, outings, and building relationships
- Strengthening your child's abilities and overall development
- Building social skills to support positive relationships at home and in the wider community
- Addressing behaviours constructively and promoting emotional wellbeing
- Encouraging independence and fostering self-care skills

We sincerely thank the parents who have been actively participating in the sessions so far. As a reminder, these modules can also be completed independently at home – please see the attached flyer for more information.

Next week we will be covering **Module 7**. Parents who have completed the previous modules are welcome to join, even if you haven't attended in person before.

These sessions have also become a valuable opportunity for parents to connect and share experiences, and we look forward to offering further workshops in the future.
