Creaney Education Support Centre caters for students with disabilities aged between four and twelve years old. Our students have varying degrees of intellectual and/or physical disabilities and/or Autism Spectrum Disorder. With specially trained staff and well-appointed facilities, we are able to offer individualised programs that best suit the diverse needs of each of our students within a safe and inclusive environment. Staff and parents work collaboratively, and in partnership with other professionals, for the benefit of each student. The success of this approach can be seen each day as we celebrate each student's steps towards increased independence.

- Mondays and Tuesdays – odd weeks 8:40am – 2:50pm

Our Kindy model includes the following core features:

- A supportive and collaborative environment with all stake holders.
- Individualised Education programs targeting key areas such as communication, social skills, motor development, behaviour and self-regulation and early literacy and numeracy skills.
- Higher staff to student ratio (1:2 or 1:3) led by a trained special education teacher and supported by education assistants.
- Collaboration with outside expertise such as speech and occupational therapists.
- Focus on communication support for all levels incorporating AAC devices, visuals and Key Word Sign for support.
- The use of evidence-based programs.
- A highly structured learning environment based on the TEACCH philosophy to support learning and independence.

Student's goals are guided by the WA curriculum, The Early Years Learning Framework, NQS and the Kindergarten curriculum guidelines. They are carefully planned and delivered to meet the student's individual needs. Goals are taught through a combination of structured one-on-one sessions and incidental learning opportunities during play, group work, and independent activities.

We believe every child deserves a positive, supportive start to school life and that every child is capable of learning, growing and achieving in their own unique way and at their own pace. We offer a balance of structure, play and exploration in a calm and supportive setting and aim to form strong relationships built on trust and respect.

A typical day includes:

- Morning circle and greetings
- Literacy and numeracy activities
- Outdoor play and gross motor time
- Sensory and fine motor experiences
- Music, movement and art
- Quiet time and reflection

At Creaney Education Support Centre, we focus on supporting positive behaviour through understanding, connection, and consistency. Our Kindy team uses proactive strategies, visual supports, and structured routines to help children feel safe, calm, and confident. We celebrate small successes and guide children to build self-regulation, social awareness, and resilience, one step at a time.
